## Personal data that we process

We process your personal data because you use our services and/or because you provide this data to us yourself. Below you will find an overview of the personal data we process:

- First and last name
- Date of birth
- Address data
- Phone number
- E-mail address
- Other personal data that you actively provide, for example in correspondence or by telephone

## Special and/or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and/or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years of age, unless they have permission from their parents or guardian. However, we cannot check whether a visitor is older than 16. We therefore recommend that parents be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children from being collected without parental consent. ## For what purpose and on what basis do we process personal data?

We process your personal data for the following purposes:

- To be able to call or email you if this is necessary to provide our services.
- For handling your payment.

## Automated decision making

We do not make decisions based on automated processing on matters that could have (significant) consequences for people.

## How long we keep personal data

We do not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected. We use the following retention periods for the following (categories) of personal data:

- Personal data provided for the execution of the agreement: as long as you are a customer and 7 years thereafter. We do this for mutual communication and the statutory retention period of the Dutch Tax Authorities.

## Sharing personal data with third parties

We do not sell your data to third parties and will only provide it if this is necessary for the execution of our agreement with you or to comply with a legal obligation. We enter into a processing agreement with companies that process your data on our behalf to ensure the same level of security and confidentiality of your data. We remain responsible for these processing operations.

## Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

The website of GivenInNature only uses analytical cookies that do not infringe your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. You can unsubscribe from cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously stored via the settings of your browser.

Cookies are placed on this website by third parties:

Cookie: Google Analytics.

Function: Analytical cookie that measures website visits.

Retention period: 2 years.

A processing agreement has been concluded with Google for this purpose. Data sharing from Google Analytics is disabled. No other Google services are used in combination with the Google Analytics cookies and the last octet of your IP address is masked.

## View, adjust or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. In addition, you have the right to withdraw your consent to data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data and you have the right

to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal data we have about you in a computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to [info@giveninnature.com](mailto:info@giveninnature.com).

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to enclose a copy of your proof of identity with the request. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and Citizen Service Number (BSN) black in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. We will respond to your request as quickly as possible, but no later than within four weeks.
